

Supply List-Mrs. L.

- 2 boxes of 24 crayons (preferably Crayola brand)
- 8 glue sticks
- 4 Ticonderoga fat pencils
- 1 watercolor paint set with more than 8 colors (for art class)
- 1 three pronged two pocket plastic folder (any color)
- 1 orange or yellow highlighter
- 4 pack low odor black Expo (dry erase) thin barrel markers
- a 1 inch **white clear view** binder
- a 3 ring zippered binder pencil pouch with a clear window (to put in clear-view binder)
- 2 white poster boards (one for classroom and one for art class))
- 2 spiral notebooks (wide ruled) 70 pages (classroom science journal and other one is for art class)
- 1 composition notebook (wide ruled) (their ABC/Math/Writing Journal)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 3 containers of baby wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package of napkins (500 count or larger)
- 1 back pack (write your **child's name** on the **outside** of it). Make sure it is big enough to transport the white binder and your child's lunch box.
- 1 lunch box (write your **child's name** on the **outside**)
- 1 bag of extra clothes to be kept at school. These clothes are used in case of spills, accidents, etc. Please include a pair of pants, a pair of shorts, one long sleeve and one short sleeve shirt, pair of socks and 2 pairs of underwear. Put these items in a Ziploc bag with your child's name written on the bag)
- **Nap time supplies-** a small blanket that will cover your child (no bedspreads or sleeping bags), and a **small sized** pillow. The child are allowed to bring **one** small stuffed soft **friend** to nap with. No hard plastic items. They will keep their stuffed friend here at school. It can be exchanged when they bring home their blanket to be washed (monthly). If your child has a special stuffed friend they need to sleep with please keep it at home because the one they bring to school needs to stay at school. Perhaps you might want to consider shopping for a "special blanket" and a "small stuffed friend" for rest time.
- One tote bag-(no suitcases) to transport pillow and blanket for rest time when being laundered. -Please make sure your **child's name** is written on the **front** of the tote bag. The tote bags will stay at school.

Optional: These are other items we use during the school year for cooking projects, art projects, and center activities. You are welcome to donate any item from the list. It is not required.

- assorted pom-poms
- gallon sized, quart sized or sandwich sized Ziploc bags
- Elmer's glue (bottle)
- Large or small paper plates
- ~~-Brown or any colored paper lunch bags (any size)~~

- multi-cultural Crayola crayons
- watercolor paint sets (8 colors)
