

Race to fill

Math lesson 4/1/2020 11-11:30

Goal/Standard: Practicing 1 to 1 correspondence, number identification, counting to 10, fine motor

Materials needed:

- FIRST Watch Jack Hartman video (click below)

- Dice
- 2-4 cups (each player needs the same size cup)
- Small objects used as counters (examples: cotton balls, erasers, marbles, beads, bouncy balls, small leggos, small blocks etc.) will need a lot!
- Tweezers (optional)

Adaptations for younger children:

Use fingers for grabbing small objects if child is not ready. Take your time! Allow wait time for children to count out dots on dice and then count out items to put in cup.

Extensions for children ready:

Use tweezers, Use bigger cups, and use two dice for students to add up all the dots.

Skills: counting up to 10, 1 to 1 correspondence, identifying numbers, following directions, listening, fine motor practice with grip, patience
