

Supply List—Mrs. Becky

- A picture of the student for our Chicka Chicka Boom Boom tree (it does not have to be professional, a 4x6 works fine).
- Lunchbox if full days. (please label with the name on the outside)
- Water bottle-preferably with an attached lid (fill daily please) these will be put on a shelf in the classroom for easy access during the day
- Rest time blanket, pillow, and small stuffed animal (without hard parts or noise makers). These will be sent home monthly to be washed and returned. This is for full day kids only.
- Reusable tote bag for rest time supplies. Please label with child's name on it. (full day kids only)
- 1 boxes of 24 crayons (preferably Crayola brand)
- 4 glue sticks
- 4 Ticonderoga fat pencils
- 1 watercolor paint set with more than 8 colors (for art class)
- 2 three pronged two pocket plastic folder (any color)
- Back pack big enough to fit a binder (please put name on the outside of it)
- Extra clothes to be kept at school. These clothes are used in case of a spill or an accident. Please put clothes in a plastic zip lock bag with their name on the outside of the bag. Please include in the bag socks, 2 pairs of underwear, a pair of shorts, a pair of long pants, a short sleeve shirt and a long sleeve shirt.
- 2 orange or yellow highlighter
- 4 pack low odor black expo (dry erase) *thin barrel* markers
- A 1 1/2 inch **white clear view** binder
- 3 white poster boards (one for classroom and one for art class)
- 3 spiral notebooks (wide ruled) 70 pages (classroom science journal, math journal and art class)
- 1 composition notebook (wide ruled) (their fine motor/writing journal)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2container disinfecting wipes
- 3 containers of baby wipes
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 package napkins
