






MEETING MINUTES

New Business:

1. Wellness Policy Implementation –

- a. The Wellness Council reviewed the Wellness Policy to be sure all required elements were included, using the **Local School Wellness Policy Implementations Under the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010: Summary of the Final Rule**
- b. All in attendance agree that the content listed in the **Summary of the Final Rule** as being required to be in the Wellness Policy was indeed in the Wellness Policy.
- c. The committee looked at the current Wellness Policy to see if we are following all the guidelines and what should be added or deleted.

2. Wellness Policy Assessment

- a. The WellSAT 2.0 was agreed upon to use as the evaluation tool of the Wellness Policy's comprehensiveness and strength.
- b. The Wellness Council spent the next hour completing the WellSAT 2.0.

3. Assessment Summary

- a. It was found that the Wellness Policy, although does contain all the required elements, does have some areas that could use more detail in their explanation.
- b. It was agreed upon that when the Wellness Committee meets next for the Triennial Assessment in 2019, that the Wellness Policy would be looked over to see what more detailed information could be added
